

# COVID-19 UPDATE as of January 16, 2023

**WE'VE HAD RESIDENTS IN OUR REMBRANDT BUILDING TEST POSITIVE FOR SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19). VISITATION WILL CONTINUE, BUT WE NEED TO INFORM YOU THAT *VISITING IS NOT RECOMMENDED*. IF YOU CHOOSE TO VISIT YOUR LOVED ONE WHILE WE ARE IN OUTBREAK STATUS, YOU NEED TO BE AWARE OF THE RISK OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19. IF YOU CHOOSE TO VISIT, YOU MUST FOLLOW BASIC INFECTION CONTROL GUIDELINES:**

- Complete guest check-in at the kiosk located at the front entrance of the Rembrandt building. A nametag will print out which is to be worn at all times during your visit.
- Facemasks covering the nose and mouth are to be worn at all times.
- Excellent hand hygiene.
- Social distancing from all residents and staff.
- Go directly to the apartment of the resident you're visiting.
- Visit in the apartment unless otherwise directed.
- Exit the facility directly after your visit.
