

COVID-19 UPDATE as of January 18, 2023

WE'VE HAD RESIDENTS IN SEVERAL BUILDINGS TEST POSITIVE FOR SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19). VISITATION WILL CONTINUE, BUT WE NEED TO INFORM YOU THAT VISITING IS NOT RECOMMENDED. IF YOU CHOOSE TO VISIT YOUR LOVED ONE WHILE WE ARE IN OUTBREAK STATUS, YOU NEED TO BE AWARE OF THE RISK OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19. IF YOU CHOOSE TO VISIT, YOU MUST FOLLOW BASIC INFECTION CONTROL GUIDELINES:

- Complete guest check-in at the kiosk located at the front entrance of the Rembrandt building. A nametag will print out which is to be worn at all times during your visit.
- Facemasks covering the nose and mouth are to be worn at all times.
- Excellent hand hygiene.
- Social distancing from all residents and staff.
- Go directly to the apartment of the resident you're visiting.
- Visit in the apartment unless otherwise directed.
- Exit the facility directly after your visit.
